Ray Cooney's hilarious sequel to *Run for your Wife* comes to The Mill Arts Centre, Banbury in the shape of BCP's production of *Caught in the Net*.

Hot on the heels of the success of Cooney's earlier farce *It Runs in the Family* director, Terry Gallager's vow "never to direct another farce" was soon to be broken. "Having dipped my toe into the Cooney waters," he says "should I try another?"

Recalling the satisfaction of a first night audience bursting into raucous laughter within minutes of the play's opening (confirming that the hard work by the whole team was well worth it) Terry resolved to fill the auditorium at The Mill Arts Centre once more, with the sound of a well-entertained audience.

The show is an up-to-date piece which sees the return of bigamist taxi-driver, John Smith, battling with his two wives, whilst at the same time trying to keep his two teenage children (one by each wife) from meeting – they having got in contact via an online dating agency. Aided and abetted by his hopeless lodger, Stanley, the ever-spiralling situation gets increasingly out of hand with riotous results.

The production opens at The Mill Arts Centre, Spiceball Pk Rd, Banbury, OX16 5QE on 1 February 2017 and runs until 4 February 2017. Curtain up 7.45pm.

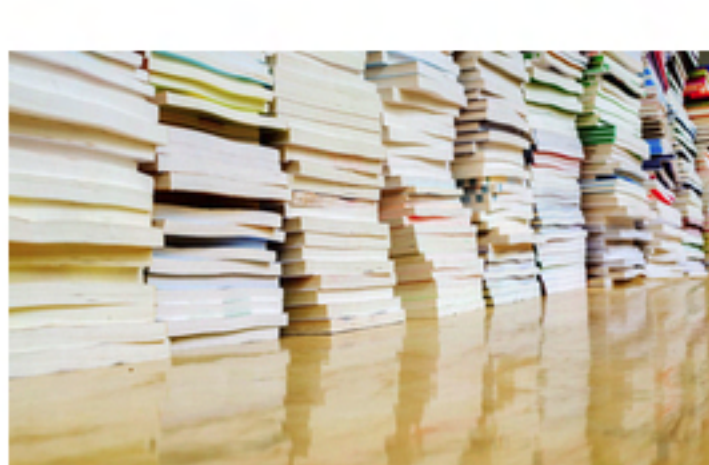

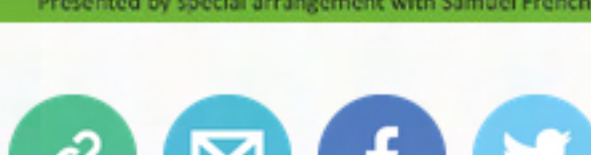
