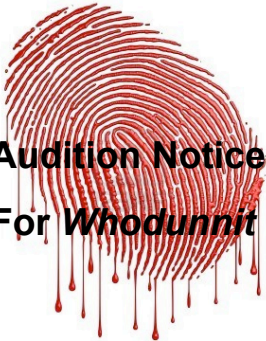


Banbury Cross Players
