Miller's powerful Drama comes to Banbury

"My first acting role was playing *Abigail* in a school production. I think the play is ageless, and as powerful now as when written" says Chrissie Garrett, director of BCP's 2016/2017 Season opening production - Arthur Miller's "The Crucible".

The play concentrates on the fate of the key figures caught up in the hysteria and persecution of the 1692 Salem witch trials and Miller wrote the play as an allegory of 1950s McCarthyism, when the US government blacklisted accused

communists.

Abigail Williams falls in love with married man, John Proctor. When Proctor tells Abigail he no longer loves her, Abigail states that John's wife Elizabeth has bewitched her. Proctor realizes he has put his wife in danger and eventually confesses his affair with Abigail, attempting to clear his wife's name.

A cast of 18 bring Miller's classic tale of moral dilemma, whistle-blowing and a shifting balance of power to The Mill Arts Centre, 2-5 November 2016. New faces and a youthful cast bring an energy to the show where the whole cast are on stage throughout – indicative that society are complicit in the deceit taking place.


