


Banbury Cross Players

This emotional and highly charged drama is the account of the anguish at the heart of a man whose storytelling continues to delight millions the world over.

Telling the story of Rudyard Kipling sending his 17 year old son, Jack, to war in

1915 : the conflict between 19yr old Jack - with defective vision but desperate to get away from home - and his father's determination to send him to war.

1915 : when Jack, despite his defective vision and aided by his father's influence, *does* go to war and is declared Missing In Action.

1924 : as Kipling and his wife desperately interview soldiers from Jack's regiment in search of news. Finally, in a bittersweet moment, they discover Jack's fate.

Colonel Pottle, Army Medical Board (40-60)


